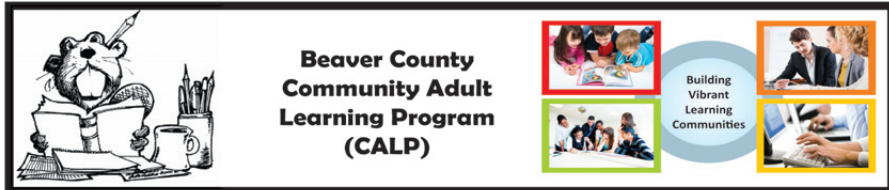

Oil and Gas Awareness Day

February 13th, 2017 marks the 70th anniversary of the Leduc No. 1 oil discovery.

The discovery of oil at Leduc in 1947 proved to be the catalyst for unlocking the province's conventional oil resources and driving Canada toward increased energy independence. The oil and gas industry has shaped contemporary Alberta more than any other.

The Alberta Urban Municipalities Association has submitted a resolution to the Government of Alberta on behalf of its members asking the province to honour the industry by declaring February 13th Oil and Gas Awareness Day in Alberta.

Beaver County Council is showing their support by marking February 13th, 2017 as Oil and Gas Awareness Day in Beaver County.

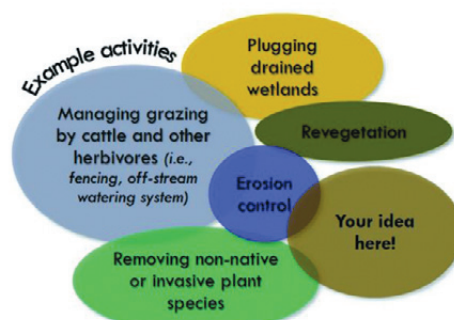
