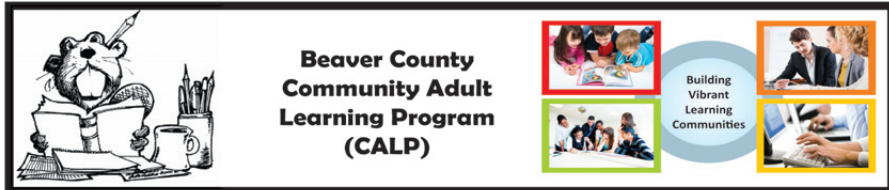

The work to be undertaken generally involves, but is not necessarily limited to, approximately 12.8 kilometers plus a possible additional 4.8km of "Graded Aggregate Seal Coat" to be carried out on the following stabilized gravel roads:

TWP Rd 492 between SH834 and Range Road 181 (8km)  
TWP 480 from HWY 36 to Range Road 130 (1.6km)  
Range Road 203 from TWP Rd 510 to TWP Rd 504 (3.2)  
TWP 514 from SH 630 to RGE

193 (4.8km) (Tentative – dependent on spring thaw)
