**Township Road 492 & 514 Construction Updates**



**Township Road 492 Being Upgraded**

Over the next few weeks (weather permitting), Township Road 492 from Highway 834 to Range Road 181 will be upgraded from a gravel road to an all-weather hard surfaced road. This involves stabilizing the road base with soil cement before applying two coats of “chip seal”. While this process is much different from the process to pave a road with asphalt, the end result will seem similar to residents and the travelling public and will result in a road that is not dusty when it is dry, nor muddy when it is wet.

During this time, the road may be closed to allow crews to work safely; however, access for local landowners will be maintained during construction. We encourage patrons to Coal Creek Golf Course, Buzzard Gulch Campground and Black Nugget Lake Campground to take alternate routes. These routes are Township Roads 490 from Highway 834, or Range Road 182 from Highway 14.

There are potential hazards to the public and vehicles during the construction process. This can include heavy machinery, dust or mud, road materials such as gravel, asphalt coatings and rock chips.

**Work Continues on Township Road 514**

Work will continue on Township Road 514 between Highway 630 and Range Road 193. The road base has been stabilized and received a “tack” coat of emulsified asphalt. The next step will be to apply a final tack coat and chip seal surface. This should go quickly but during this time, please try to take another route to your destination if possible. This schedule is weather dependent.

During this time, there will be crews on the road who need to work safely, and road coatings being applied that can make your vehicle dirty. Finally, there will be loose rock chips present for some time after application that can scratch your vehicle. The final chips will be brushed off after the surface has cured (generally after a few weeks). Please be advised the speed limit is 50 km/h while posted.

At this time, both projects are on hold due to the wet weather. Construction will continue as soon as it begins to dry up. Thank you for your patience and understanding during construction. If you have any questions, please call the Beaver County Service Centre at 780-663-3730.

**Failure to receive your PROPERTY TAX NOTICE does not exempt you from penalties.**

Property notices have been mailed out to residents of Beaver County. If you are a new resident of Beaver County or if your mailing address has changed in the last year, it is your responsibility to notify Beaver County of your correct/current address or any changes that have occurred. All tax notices are mailed out to the current address we have on file. Failure to receive your tax notice does not exempt you from penalty deadlines and due dates do not change due to returned mail. If you have not received your property tax notice for 2017 or are unsure we have received your correct mailing address, please contact the Beaver County Service Centre at (780)663-3730 to confirm.
