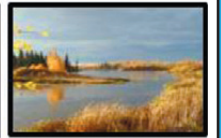

URGENT – Returned 2017 Property Tax Notice

Failure to receive your PROPERTY TAX NOTICE does not exempt you from penalties.

Property notices have been mailed out to residents of Beaver County. If you are a new resident of Beaver County or if your mailing address has changed in the last year, it is your responsibility to notify Beaver County of your correct/current address or any changes that have occurred. All tax notices are mailed out to the current address we have on file. Failure to receive your tax notice does not exempt you from penalty deadlines and due dates do not change due to returned mail. If you have not received your property tax notice for 2017 or are unsure we have received your correct mailing address, please contact the Beaver County Service Centre at (780)663-3730 to confirm.
