

Seeking Election Workers

The County is seeking to fill the positions of Deputy Returning Officers on Election Day, October 16, 2017. The rate of pay is \$275 per day, plus mileage. Deputy Returning Officers are needed for voting stations located at:

- Lindbrook Community Hall
- Spilstead Community Hall
- Tofield Community Hall
- Viking Seniors Centre
- Kinsella Community Hall
- Stand-by workers are also needed to ensure all positions are filled should a cancellation occur.

Individuals can apply to work as DROs on Election Day if:

- They are at least 18 years old;
- Available to attend a ½ day, daytime training session on October 3; and
- Available to work extended hours (> 12 hours) on Election Day (October 16).

Prior experience with municipal elections is an asset.

An Advance Vote will be held on October 5 at some voting stations. Some DROs will be asked to work on this day (1-9 pm).

Anyone who meets these qualifications and would like to be a part of the election team is asked to submit an application to the Beaver County Service Centre, 5120 – 50 Street, Ryley Alberta, Monday to Friday between 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Applications are open now and will be accepted until noon on September 18, 2017. Township Road 480
