### Bulk Water Truck Fills

The Highway 14 Regional Water Services Commission operates a network of bulk water truck fills in Beaver County to make water available to County Residents. The truck fills all operate on a prepaid customer dispensing system. When a customer has an account, they can obtain water at any of the Highway 14 Water Truck Fills.

Customers can make a payment on their account at their financial institution, by calling our office or can now access their account any time online. Setting up new accounts or making prepayments can be done by going to [www.hwy14water.ca](http://www.hwy14water.ca) and on the "Home" page look at new postings to find the link "New Online Self Serve Bulk Water System."
