### 2017 Property Taxes

**Property taxes are due October 31, 2017.** Failure to receive your PROPERTY TAX NOTICE does not exempt you from penalties.

Property notices have been mailed out to residents of Beaver County. If you are a new resident of Beaver County or if your mailing address has changed in the last year, it is your responsibility to notify Beaver County of your correct/current address or any changes that have occurred. All tax notices are mailed out to the current address we have on file. Failure to receive your tax notice does not exempt you from penalty deadlines and due dates do not change due to returned mail.

Beaver County Community Adult Learning Program will be hosting a **GED PREPARATION** course offered by *Academic Express Adult Education and Training*. Apply now for September to ensure you have a spot. An interview to assess program suitability and eligibility for financial aid is required. We have a limit of 10 students per session.

The **GED is a High School Equivalency Diploma**, and is recognized by many employers throughout Alberta. The **GED Preparation** class is a 100 hour video conferenced class that prepares you to challenge the **GED Exam**. The program consists of 5 subjects – Social Studies, Science, Math, English Literature and Grammar, and an essay. All 5 subjects must be passed in order to receive the **GED Diploma** from **Alberta Education**. There is an on-site instructor to assist you with your learning during class times.

**This program is conditional upon Government of Alberta funding. Student Financial Aid is available through a Part-time Studies Grant if you fall within the income threshold for eligibility.**

#### Township Road 480
