## 2017 Property Taxes

### Beaver County Deadline for Payment of 2017 Property Taxes

The deadline for payment of the 2017 property taxes is as follows:

TUESDAY, OCTOBER 31, 2017 (if paid in person at the County Office).  
or  
Postmarked on or before October 31, 2017 (if paid by mail).  
or  
Payment processing dated on or before October 31, 2017 (if paid online).

To avoid line-ups, please consider early remittance. Postdated cheques are being accepted.

INTERAC, cheques, online and telephone banking are encouraged. Please ensure adequate time for payment processing. If you missed us during regular office hours, please use the mail drop box at the Beaver County Service Centre located at 5120 50 Street, Ryley, Alberta.

A penalty of 12% will be added to outstanding CURRENT taxes on November 1, 2017.

Hours for the Beaver County Service Centre are: 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. (weekdays).

Please call ahead (780-663-3730) if an appointment with the Assessor is required.

## Emergency Communications Notice

### Strathcona County Emergency Communications Notice

Strathcona County Emergency Communications Centre wishes to advise you that they have transitioned to a new 9-1-1 phone system effective **Monday, September 25, 2017**.

**What does this mean for the communities they serve?** When someone in the service area dials 9-1-1, emergency calls will continue to be received and professionally handled in the same proficient, seamless manner as always. There will be no impact to residents.

However the long-dial "Alarm Line" number (780-449-6707) that **alarm monitoring companies** use to contact their centre is changing.

Although some single-family homes use alarm monitoring, the majority of users are multi-family developments, schools, care facilities, public service buildings and commercial businesses. It is important that these facilities are notified of the change so they may advise their respective alarm monitoring contractors.

There will be a transition period during which users dialling the old contact number will be call forwarded to the new contact number, including a recorded message advising of the change. This will give users in the area ample time to notify their alarm monitoring companies of the change so procedural documentation can be updated with the new number.
