The **GED is a High School Equivalency Diploma**, and is recognized by many employers throughout Alberta. The **GED Preparation** class is a 100 hour video conferenced class that prepares you to challenge the **GED Exam**. The program consists of 5 subjects – Social Studies, Science, Math, English Literature and Grammar, and an essay. All 5 subjects must be passed in order to receive the **GED Diploma** from Alberta Education. There is an on-site instructor to assist you with your learning during class times.

Student Financial Aid is available through a Part-time Studies Grant if you fall within the income threshold for eligibility.
