The program consists of 5 subjects – Social Studies, Science, Math, English Literature and Grammar, and an essay. All 5 subjects must be passed in order to receive the **GED Diploma** from **Alberta Education**. There is an on-site instructor to assist you with your learning during class times.

**Student Financial Aid is available through a Part-time Studies Grant if you fall within the income threshold for eligibility.**
