### 2018 Beaver County Road Construction

#### Township Road 492 Being Upgraded

Over the next few weeks, Township Road 492 from Highway 834 to Range Road 181 will be upgraded from a graveled road to an all-weather hard surfaced road. This involves stabilizing the road base with soil cement before applying two coats of "chip seal". While this process is much different from the process of paving a road with asphalt, the end result will seem similar to residents and the travelling public this will result in a road that is not dusty when it is dry, nor muddy when it is wet.

During this time, the road at times may be closed to allow crews to work safely; however, access for local landowners will be maintained during construction. We encourage patrons of Coal Creek Golf Course, Buzzard Gulch Campground and Black Nugget Lake Campground to take alternate routes. These routes are Township Roads 494 or 490 from Highway 834, or Range Road 182 from Highway 14.

There are potential hazards to the public and vehicles during the construction process. This can include heavy machinery, dust or mud, road materials such as gravel, asphalt coatings and rock chips.

Please be advised the speed limit is 50 km/h while posted.

### Notice of Public Hearing


#### NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING For the purpose of hearing arguments for and against the road closure of Twp Rd 480

Under the authority of the Municipal Government Act, Section 22, Beaver County Council is considering the passage of Bylaw 18-1055 to close to public travel, a portion of undeveloped road allowance containing 0.38 hectares (0.95 acres), described as follows:

Meridian 4 Range 13 Township 48

All that portion of the original government road allowance adjoining the south boundary of South East Quarter of Section 3 which lies west of a line drawn at right angles from a point on the north boundary of the said road allowance 30.5 meters distant westerly from the southeast corner of the said section, and which also lies east of the production southeasterly of the northeast limit of G.T.P. No. 1 across the said road allowance.

This road closure and subsequent sale of the road will form part of the property where a grain elevator and rail spur operation are being developed in the SE 3-48-13-W4.



Council will hear arguments for and against the application at a public hearing scheduled for 10:00 am, Wednesday, June 20, 2018, at the Beaver County Service Centre in Ryley, Alberta.

Written submissions may be provided to Beaver County Council during the public hearing, however it is requested that a copy of the written submission be delivered to the Service Centre (5120-50 Street, Ryley), attention the Chief Administrative Officer, no later than 4:30 pm, Wednesday, June 13, 2018.

If you submit comments regarding the bylaw in writing, the information you provide may be made public, subject to the provisions of the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*.
