



COUNCIL MEETING HIGHLIGHTS FEBRUARY 14, 2017

Viking RCMP Detachment – Cpl. Brad Mouland

Cpl. Brad Mouland, Viking RCMP Detachment, attended the meeting and provided Council with Occurrence Stats for 2015 and 2016. Cpl. Mouland also requested that Council provide input regarding priorities for 2017/2018.

Road Priorities

Council adopted a revised Road Construction Priorities Policy, and accepted the Rural Road Study 2016 Update as a tool to be used to prepare a 5-year road plan.

Revisions to Camp Lake Campground

Council authorized Administration to make upgrades to the Campground by adding one large group site and changing two existing sites into group sites.

Beaver Municipal Solutions Surplus Funds

Beaver County will request Beaver Municipal Solutions to process a request to the Minister of Municipal Affairs for Permission to Distribute Surplus Funds in 2018 and 2019.

Financial Indicators

Alberta Municipal Affairs (MA) annually prepares financial indicator graphs for municipalities. MA sets up comparators for each municipality based on a number of factors and Beaver County is compared against these municipalities. Council reviewed the 2015 financial indicators.

Request for Qualifications – Regional Waterline Study

Council authorized administration to begin a process to secure a consultant to prepare the Regional Water Strategy based on an agreed upon Request for Qualifications process.

Viking Annexation Negotiating Committee

Council appointed Councillors Collison and Hanson to the Viking Annexation Negotiating Committee.

Beaver Emergency Services Grader Shed Lease

Council authorized a new six-year lease agreement with Beaver Emergency Services Commission (BESC) for the Bruce Grader Shed.
