Thank you for extending the deadline for submission of Statements of Concern regarding Clean Harbors Canada, Inc.'s application for a lateral expansion of its facility in the Village of Ryley (NE 9-50-17-W4). In accordance with the public notice, Beaver County Council wishes to file the following Statement of Concern.

Beaver County is the rural municipality within which the Village of Ryley is located. Lands within the County's jurisdiction lie adjacent to the NE 9-50-17-W4, the subject of Clean Harbors' application. Nearly ten rural residences are located within a one-mile radius of the site and numerous residences are located in the surrounding area. There are many wetlands and creeks on surrounding land. The County's industrial park lies ½ to 1 mile southeast of the NE 9.

Beaver County Council, on behalf of the rural residents it serves, submits the following concerns:

1. Clean Harbors' activities may negatively affect air quality, groundwater, and above-ground water run-off. It is therefore requested that Clean Harbors be required to submit real-time air monitoring, groundwater monitoring, and above-ground water run-off testing on a regular basis.
2. Mud from vehicles exiting Clean Harbors' facility tracks onto the adjacent road. This debris may contain contaminants from the site and/or may create a safety hazard for the travelling public. It is therefore requested that Clean Harbors be required to implement a system that eliminates mud from tracking onto the roadway.



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3. The effects of Clean Harbors' operation extend beyond the distance within which the applicant is required to notify affected landowners. It is therefore requested that Clean Harbors be required to expand its stakeholder notification area for a distance greater than one mile from the site.
