



COUNCIL MEETING HIGHLIGHTS REGULAR MEETING JANUARY 16, 2019

Northern Lights Library System

Julie Walker, Executive Director, and Larry Tiedemann, Chairman, Northern Lights Library System, attended the meeting and provided Council with an overview on the value of the services provided annually by the Northern Lights Library System to Beaver County residents.

Strategic Steps

Ian McCormack of Strategic Steps attended the meeting and provided Council with an overview of their roles and responsibilities and the importance of setting out strategic priorities that align with the County's vision.

Clean Harbors

Stan Yuha, Facility Manager, Mike Parker, Vice President of Environmental Compliance, Clean Harbors, and Bryan Hensel, TetraTech Engineering, attended the meeting to address concerns regarding the Response to Statement of Concerns Regarding Amendment Application No. 015-10348 for lateral expansion of the Ryley Industrial Waste Management Facility. They also presented a proposal to provide funding to either the County or Village of Ryley for a "third party" annual review of Clean Harbor's environmental reporting, and a commitment to provide the tri-annual audit report for review of the County and Village.

Five Year Road Plan

Council approved the 5 Year Road Plan for 2019 – 2023.

Bridgerail Height Policy

Council approved the Bridgerail Height Policy.

Beaver Management Policy

At the January 2nd Committee of the Whole and Special Council meeting, Council considered various changes to the Pest Control Level of Service Policy. Changes included:

- the removal of beavers from the Pest Control Level of Service Policy and development of a standalone beaver management policy
- development of a fee for service for beaver management works on private land
- beaver management within municipally licensed water management projects
- suspension of the Beaver Bounty Program
- the extension of the current Landflood Control Contract, and
- the inclusion of works within licensed water management projects into the contract scope of work.
