

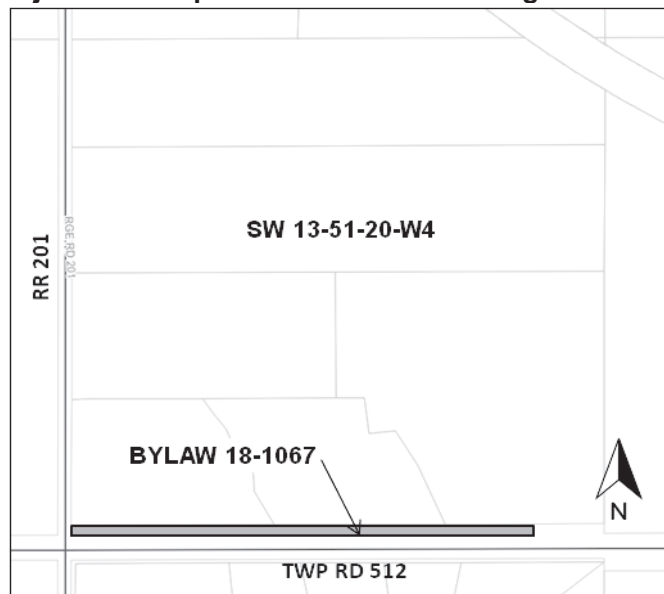
## Notice of Public Hearing

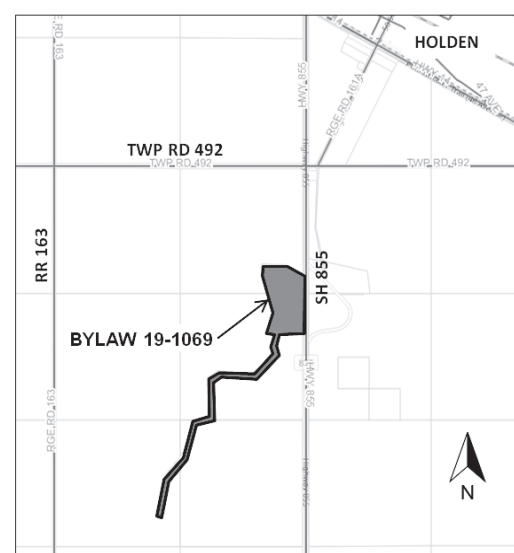
## Notice of Public Hearing
