Residents must apply for dust control by 4:30 p.m., April 15, 2019 for the May/June suppressant application to:

The fee will be imposed as a fee-for-service, calculated on the basis of 50% of the cost of the dust suppression product. Beaver County shall provide 50% of the cost per application once per calendar year.
