#### Beaver County and Black Nugget Lake Parks response to COVID-19

On March 27th Beaver County closed vehicle access to Black Nugget Lake Park including the ice fishing area.

Beaver County's restrictions are the same as Alberta provincial parks, public land is temporarily suspended due to public safety concerns resulting from COVID-19.

Included in the vehicle access closures are public land recreation areas, where parking lots and all facilities, including washrooms, are closed.

We recognize that this news is disappointing, however the safety of our parks visitors and minimizing the spread of COVID-19 is our top priority.

This is about everyone's safety and we hope that everyone complies. Enforcement Officers will be doing routine checks.
