Campground Operations

On April 15th, 2020 Beaver County Council made the difficult decision to postpone Beaver County's campground opening dates.

Due to COVID-19, the campground opening dates for Black Nugget Lake Campground and Camp Lake Campground have been pushed back to **June 26, 2020**, unless this date can change to be sooner based on recommendations from the Province of Alberta and Alberta Health Services.

Additionally, the day-use areas at both parks will remain closed as well as the fishing area at Black Nugget Lake Park will remain closed.

The health and safety of our residents, visitors, staff, and contractors is our top priority. These measures are in line with Provincial recommendations to practice physical distancing.

Campground Reservations

Our campground reservation system is now taking reservations for June 26, 2020 onward. For those who have already made reservations, we are working on processing refunds or rebookings.

2020 Strychnine Sales

Due to the current circumstances with COVID-19, strychnine sales will be done by appointment only, beginning April 21, 2020.

This can be arranged by calling 780-663-3730 and speaking with the Agriculture Department.

Beaver County will be selling 2% Liquid Strychnine Concentrate to farmers who are experiencing severe Richardson Ground Squirrel infestations in annual crops, forage crops, rangeland and pastures.

****PRICE**** \$10.50 per 250 ml vial or \$250.00 per case

- MAXIMUM of two (2) cases may be purchased based on infestation level.
- Legal land locations will be required for ALL areas intended for application.
- Persons whose farming status is unknown to the County will be required to produce documentation that shows involvement in an active farming operation.

Payment will ONLY be accepted by check or prearranged credit card payment.
