Pursuant to the Traffic Safety Act the County hereby orders that effective **June 15, 2020 at 8:00 am** the following percentage axle weights of public vehicles apply on the following roads:

Paved Roads All	75%
Chip Sealed Roads All	100%
Except for: a) Rge Rd 191 between Twp Rd 512 to 53rd Ave Tofield, AB	75%
b) Twp Rd 512 between Hwy 630 to Rge Rd 195	75%
c) Twp Rd 502 between Rge Rd 201 - 205	75%
d) Rge Rd 182 between Twp Rd 494 to Black Nugget Lake Park Entrance	75%
e) Twp Rd 492 between Hwy 834 - 854	75%
