### Beaver County Office Closed

On November 26, 2020, the Beaver County Region (including all the towns and villages within the County) moved into ENHANCED status on the Provincial Government's COVID status map.

To move into Enhanced status, the active case rate must be 50 cases per 100,000 population with a minimum of 10 active cases. The County reached 10 active cases on November 26.
