2021 Municipal Election

2021 is the year of municipal elections and October 18, 2021 is Election Day.

In the past, submission of nominations was restricted to one day only. The Local Authorities Election Act has been amended to extend the time period during which nominations can be filed. **The new Nomination Period is January 1, 2021 to noon on Monday, September 20, 2021.**

At any time during this period, a candidate may submit a Nomination Form. The Nomination Form as well as a Candidate Information Package is available on the County's website at www.beaver.ab.ca/council/2021-municipal-election. ****PRICE** \$11.63 per 250 ml vial or \$279.00 per case**

MAXIMUM of two (2) cases may be purchased based on infestation level.

Legal land locations will be required for ALL areas intended for application.
