Late Payment of Beaver County Property Taxes

Beaver County distributes property tax notices in mid-May every year. To avoid late-payment penalties, Beaver County asks property owners to pay their taxes upon receipt, taxes are penalty free until Monday, November 1, 2021.

If you did not pay the total amount of taxes due by the Monday, November 1, 2021 deadline, Beaver County imposes a late payment penalty of 6% on current taxes owed on Tuesday, November 2, 2021.

An additional penalty of 3% will be added to all outstanding taxes January 18th.
