

Beaver County Council Seeks Public Input to Guide County Programs

January 05, 2022 – Beaver County Council has begun seeking public input for a variety of County programs. County Council will be surveying the public to guide changes to the following County Policies:

- Level of Service Overland Drainage
- Pest Control Level of Service
- Road Maintenance Level of Service
- Road Rehabilitation Priorities

County Council recognizes that good governance includes engaging County residents and municipal stakeholders. There is a need for those who are affected by a decision, to influence the decision. Information gathered during the public participation process will be used to inform Council and assist in the decision making process.

The key programs identified in the survey include water management and beaver control, shoulder pulls, dust control, selling culverts, hard surfacing roads, winter road maintenance, summer road maintenance, roadside mowing, roadside ditch maintenance, and road rebuilding. Residents and stakeholders are also able to provide comments on other County services.

An online survey has been created to gather public input and can be accessed on the County website at www.beaver.ab.ca. Hard copies of the survey have been made available at the Beaver County Service Centre, libraries, and urban municipal offices within the County. The survey can also be emailed to residents. If municipal stakeholders wish to provide written comments, instead of completing the survey, they may submit written comments to the Beaver County Service Centre.

County Council is keen to hear from residents and determine priorities based on feedback from across the County. **Surveys will be accepted until January 19th, 2022**. Do not miss this opportunity to provide input and guide future decision making.
