

## Planning for the future of EMS in Alberta

Alberta Health Services (AHS) has heard from more than 1,000 Albertans in response to their EMS Current State Survey and the survey findings will be used to direct the development of the Provincial EMS Service Plan.

The learnings from the survey and engagement will be used to inform the development of the EMS Provincial Service Plan. This Plan, which will be forward-looking and focused on continued improvement, is one element of the AHS EMS 10-Point Plan which has been implemented to address system pressures.

To kick off the Future Planning Process, AHS is forming working groups to address the six priorities that emerged from the current state work. Members of these groups will integrate the feedback provided by Albertans, and provide subject matter expertise to guide AHS's next steps.
