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NOTE:

- 1. Beaver County may construct one approach to each freehold quarter section from an existing developed road. One approach per fragmented parcel may also be permitted from an existing developed road.
- 2. Approval for widening of existing approaches or construction of additional approaches shall be as per the Road Approaches Policy PW-010.
- 3. Approaches shall be constructed to the County's Road Approach Standard.
- 4. Temporary approach removals shall be completed at the applicant's cost and the ditch restored to original or better condition by the removal date specified by the Special Provisions.
- 5. Applicant to notify Beaver County Public Works Department when approach is complete and ready for inspection.
- 6. Proposed new approach locations shall be inspected by Beaver County Public Works Department prior to approval.
- 7. Applicant shall clearly mark the proposed approach location by placing flagged stakes at both sides of the approach location.
- 8. Applicant to contact Alberta One Call and locate all buried utilities prior to construction.

The sketch plan should indicate the following:

- Location of proposed approach, dimensioned from the closest property corner;
- Boundaries of the affected parcel including dimensions;
- All affected drainage courses;
- All roads adjacent to the parcel labeled;
- Location of any existing approach(es) on both sides of the road;
- Location of any existing approach(es) on the affected parcel;
- North arrow for orientation.
