

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR ACCESS TO TWP RD 510 AND RGE RD 205/SPILSTEAD RD

On Friday June 23, the Canadian Road Cycling Championships will take place in Beaver and Strathcona counties on Twp Rd 510 and Rge Rd 205/Spilstead Rd. Races will run throughout the day. Traffic will be disrupted from 5:00am to 8:00pm. During this time, the mailboxes at the main intersection of Twp Rd 510 & Rge Rd 204/205/Spilstead road may not be accessible. We're sending this letter to residents who will be affected by the event. The course map is on the back of this page.

What races are being held here? The Time Trial event of the Canadian Road Cycling Championships, the most prestigious cycling event on the domestic racing calendar. Participants include the most elite cyclists in Canada and some of our top professional riders. Races are for junior women and men, elite women and men, and Para cyclists.

When is the Time Trial event? Friday, June 23, rain or shine. Road closures will begin at 5:00am. Races take place throughout the day. We expect the roads to fully open by 8:00pm.

How will I access my home/property? Twp Rd 510 and Rge Rd 205 (Spilstead Road) will be closed to the public. However, residents will be able to drive on the course and enter/exit on the nearest range road or township road. We ask for your patience as there may be delays for drivers. Please follow the driving guidance given below to ensure your safety the safety of cyclists.

GUIDANCE FOR DRIVERS

- Speed limit is 50 km/h.
- Stay alert, take great care when passing cyclists. Riders will be coming from both directions.
- Take direction from course marshals.

ENTRY/EXIT POINTS (SEE MAP)

Use the nearest range road or township road to limit time on the racecourse. Generally, your location will determine the best entry and exit point. There are two exceptions:

- ALL DAY: no exit or entry at the intersection of Township Road 510 & Range Road 204/205 (Spilstead Road). This intersection is completely closed and impassable all day.
- INTERMITTENT: no exit or entry at race turnaround points. Depending on the race, turnaround points are located at different intersections on Twp Rd 510 and Spilstead Rd. Course marshals will know turnaround locations at the time you are driving.

TWP RD 510 should be entered/exited by the nearest range road.

RGE RD 205/Spilstead Rd can be entered/exited by township roads 504 and 502.
