WHEREAS, the "Owner" is the owner of the following Municipal Address (911):

□ Landowner □ Renter (Must receive landowners' permission) □ Senior □ Health Restrictions

WHEREAS The Owner desires the County to snowplow/grade his/her private driveway when such driveway becomes impassable or hazardous due to conditions.

NOW, THEREFORE, the County and the Owner for the consideration hereinafter named, agree as follows:

- 1. The County will determine whether the service can be provided without causing damage in terms of the width of the area or turning area.
- 2. The owner hereby agrees to prepay the half-hour (30 minutes) minimum set by the bylaw and the County will complete per policy.
- 3. Owner will advise the office when driveways require this service.
- 4. Owners in multi-lot subdivisions shall post their lot number on the driveway where it will be visible.
- 5. Residents who are seniors or have health restrictions will receive a maximum of six (6) free snow removals. Appropriate documentation may be requested.
- 6. The Owner hereby covenants and agrees that they will always indemnify and save harmless the County, their servants, agents, and employees from and against all loss, damage, or injury however caused, which may at any time during the continuance of this Agreement occur to any person or the property of any person including the Owner.
- 7. The Owner hereby covenants and agrees that any damage to the Owner's property resulting from snowplowing/grading operations shall be at the Owner's sole risk.
