## **POSITION DETAILS:**

- Position Type: Permanent Full-Time
- Hours of Work: Available to work non-regular hours if required, as per section six (6) “Hours of Work” of the Collective Agreement with I.U.O.E. local 955.

## **ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Operate a grader to remove snow, grade roads, and ensure proper drainage.
- Perform pre-winter, spring, and summer maintenance on roads including upkeep of roads, signs and bridges.
- Maintain easements, roads, and transportation systems ensuring safe conditions.
- Perform daily safety and maintenance checks while also maintaining equipment inventory.
- Ensure heavy equipment is safely and securely stored.
- Clean equipment as scheduled and/or as needed.
- Conduct general servicing of equipment and assist with other assigned duties.
- Advise the Manager of Transportation of any requirements for maintenance or repairs.
- Reports to the Manager of Transportation, performing duties as a heavy equipment operator III, with additional tasks as required.

- High School Diploma or equivalent G.E.D.
- Grader operation is an asset.
