Beaver County is seeking to fill the following positions on Municipal Election Day, October 20, 2025. Position descriptions can be viewed on the County website.

## RATE OF PAY \*

\$375.00 /day

Deputy Returning Officers

\$315.00 /day

Stand-by workers (*must be available on short notice should a cancellation occur*)    ½ of position rate

*\* Rates of pay reflect extended hours of work from 7 am to completion of ballot counting on Election Day.*

## LOCATIONS

Election workers will be assigned to one of the voting stations located at:

- Lindbrook Community Hall
- Spilstead Community Hall
- Tofield Community Hall
- Ryley Legion
- Bruce Community Centre
- Viking Seniors Centre
- Kinsella Community Hall

## REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible to work as an election worker, individuals must meet the following requirements:

- Minimum of 18 years of age,
- Have reliable transportation,
- Prior experience with municipal elections is an asset.
- Available to attend a daytime training session on October 9, and
- Available to work between the hours of 7 a.m. to completion of ballot counting on Election Day (October 20).

Advance Votes will be held during the week of October 14-16 in some locations. Some DROs will be asked to work on these days (includes evenings).

## TO APPLY

Anyone who meets the required qualifications and would like to be a part of the election team is asked to complete the application form which can be found on the County website. **Applications will be accepted until 4:30 p.m., July 31, 2025.**
