

### Dust Control

The application of Dust Control on Beaver County roads is scheduled to begin May 1st starting in the east end of the County and moving west. It is expected to take approximately 4 -5 weeks to complete weather permitting.

The Dust Control application deadline was April 15, 2019. ### TOWNSHIP ROAD 512

Within a short time, road construction will begin on Township Road 512 from Range Road 195 to Secondary Highway 630. An additional tack coat will be applied to protect the road as we wait on the completion of warranty work. We are unable to confirm date & time as this process is extremely warm weather dependant.

During the application process roads may be closed, this allows crews to work safely, although we encourage alternate routes whenever possible access for local landowners will be maintained. Keep in mind that transference of material may occur if you proceed on the road while product is being applied.

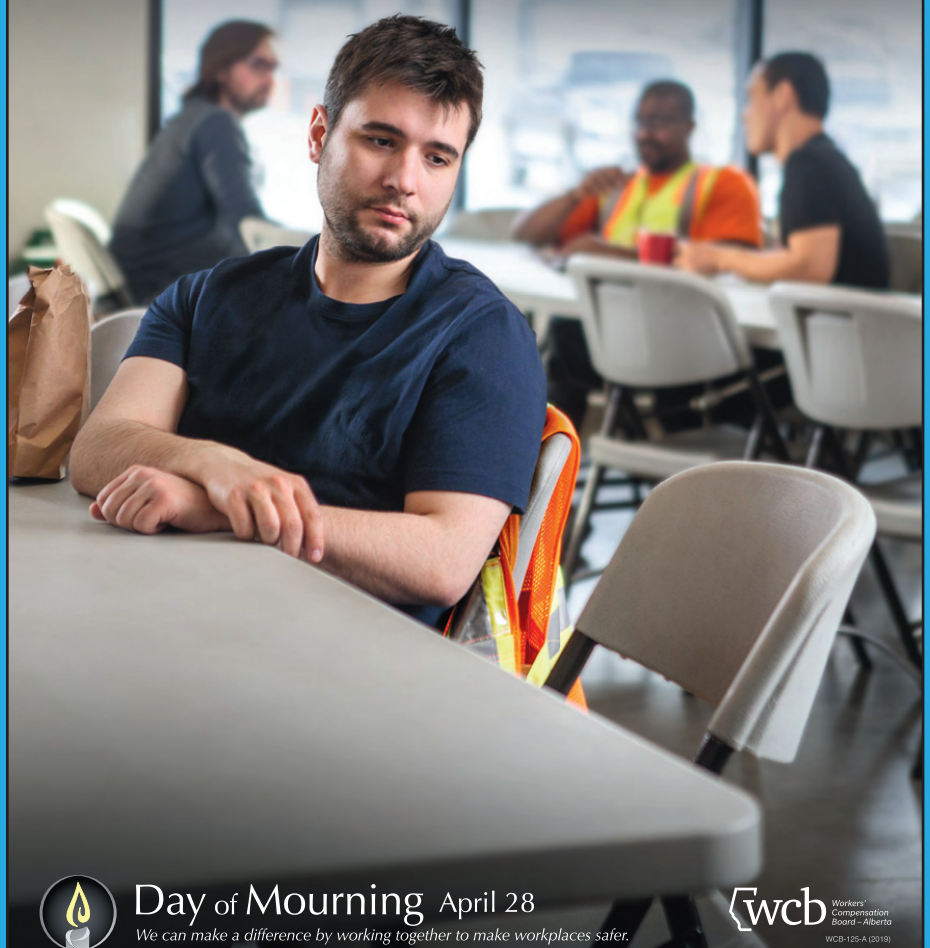
