

2% Liquid Strychnine

NOTE: Beginning June 10, 2019, strychnine sales will be done by appointment only. This can be arranged by calling 780-663-3730 and speak with the Agriculture Department.

Beaver County will be selling 2% Liquid Strychnine Concentrate to farmers who are experiencing severe Richardson Ground Squirrel infestations in annual crops, forage crops, rangeland and pastures.

****PRICE**** \$10.50 per 250 ml vial or \$250.00 per case

- MAXIMUM of two (2) cases may be purchased based on infestation level.
- Legal land locations will be required for ALL areas intended for application.
- Persons whose farming status is unknown to the County will be required to produce documentation that shows involvement in an active farming operation.
- Payment by cash, cheque, debit or credit
- All sales occur at the Beaver County Service Centre, Ryley
